Dastaar Competition Guidelines

We all are hereby acknowledging that the judge's decision will be final and should be accepted respectfully.

The whole idea of the competition is to have our respect for dastaar and to encourage everyone to wear it regularly.

1. First prize winners from previous years cannot compete in the same group and only can compete in higher groups
2. Participant's parents or immediate relatives cannot participate in the judging
3. Coaching during competition is strictly prohibited
4. Time limit is 15 minutes. Every additional minute over the allowed 15 minutes will result in a ten point penalty. Time limit penalty will be incorporated by the coordinator and not by the judges.
5. Time warning will be given at 10, 13 and then 15 minutes
6. No bias based on different styles, Gol vs. peaked vs, dumaalla, and / or any other style
7. Please ask sevadaars for help to do poonhi (ਪੂਣੀ) and for any other specific requirement
8. Once the time starts, second poonhi help can be provided at the cost of participant's time
9. Other than doing poonhi, sevadaars or judges cannot and will not help during dastaar tying
10. Adjust your mirror properly for your height before starting
11. After you are done please go outside the room for the picture
12. Judges will follow the following guidelines:
 - Overall appeal 30
 - Neatness of folds 10
 - Hair in 10
 - Respect of Dastaar 10
